



## Dusk To Dawn Group LLC

### Program & House Rules

#### General Information

1. You are not allowed to use or possess alcohol, drugs (including marijuana), medications not prescribed to you, or drug paraphernalia. Re-occurring Drug and Alcohol use may lead to a housing exit. If you have a recurrence of use of drugs or alcohol, you must self-report immediately to Dusk To Dawn Group LLC's management. Not disclosing quickly and completely places your housing at risk.
2. Only prescription drugs prescribed by your healthcare provider are permitted in the house. No cough syrup, unless it is prescribed. Any prescribed medication must be kept in a locked box with a copy of the prescription given to Nadia James or Nadette James. Sharing of medication, or possession of medication not prescribed to you is cause for an exit.
3. You are required to develop and implement your personal recovery plan. This plan includes 3 meetings per week if you are employed and 5 meetings per week if you're currently unemployed. If unemployed, you should be seeking employment, volunteering, or attending school during the daytime.
4. Curfew is midnight on Friday and Saturday night. Curfew is 10 PM Sunday through Thursday night. No exceptions unless approved by the House Manager. We enforce the curfew unless you have a check out slip from work.
5. Approved overnight requests are a privilege. Approvals may not be granted in the first 30 days of the program or if you are having difficulty following the rules of the program. You must submit an overnight request 24 hours in advance. NO CALL – NO SHOW at the house for 48 hours may result in an exit.
6. You will have a baseline urinalysis drug test (UA) when you arrive. Random housing UA's will be required. The house manager or any guest may request a random UA. Failure to take a UA when asked may lead to a housing exit. If you are under the influence of drugs or alcohol or have substances in your UA, you may be removed from housing immediately. If you use someone else's urine sample or synthetic (store bought) urine for your UA, you may be exited immediately.
7. There will be both scheduled and random room searches for all guests. Rooms may be searched for drugs or contraband at any time. You are not allowed to possess guns, knives, or other weapons. Possession of these items will cause an exit.
8. Dusk To Dawn Group LLC will inspect the home weekly and provide a report card. Discrepancies will be addressed at the weekly House Meeting.
9. Visitors are NOT allowed. The only exception is family members to tour your house on move in or at a pre-arranged time; this must be approved by Dusk To Dawn Group LLC's management. NO overnight visitors are allowed under any conditions. NO persons under the age of 18 is allowed anywhere on the property at any time, unless discussed with the managers.
10. If you give your entry code to someone else, or let someone in on your code, that is considered a breach of house safety and will be grounds for an exit. This will lead to a change in door codes.
11. You are expected to participate in house chores and they will be assigned monthly. There are daily, weekly and monthly house chores. If you cannot do your chore, you need to make

- arrangements with another guest to cover it for you. The house will be deep cleaned by guests every week.
12. All rules regarding how we treat each other, the house and guest's personal property should be complied with.
  13. If you are asked to leave the home because you failed to comply with the house rules, there is no refund of the contribution or supply fee already paid.
  14. The Contribution Fee of \$720 is due on the 1st of the month. There is a late fee of \$25 each day for the 2nd and 3rd day of the month. If the contribution fee is not paid by the 3rd day of the month, you are expected to leave the house by 8:00 am on the 4th day of the month. Any exceptions to this rule must be requested from Dusk To Dawn Group LLC's management before the 1st of the month.
  15. There is a supply fee that will be used to furnish the house with toiletries, cleaning supplies and other items that are consumed by everyone in the home. This amount would not typically exceed \$20 a month. The supply fee is due on the 1st of the month with your contribution fee.
